II. **PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF THE PROJECT 'ANNA KÉTHLY POLITICAL SCHOOL'**

Description

This political Academy aims to train the next generation of Hungarian progressive political actors through meaningful cooperation, promoting continuous renewal and a more forward-looking political alternative that is attractive to younger generations. It also puts the focus on the future-shaping power of eco-social progressive powers. Always under a European perspective.

This project is framed in the third pillar of FEPS Training Strategy and it will be directly related with the FEPS AAA and FEPS Open Progressive University providing both initiatives with content and participants. FEPS will be involved in the thematic dimension of the project and will play a leading role in the organization of the programme of the "Brussels" visit.

Objective

The main objective of this political academy is to train young progressive talent reaching the highest possible standards for political engagement. To promote this political participation of young people, ISD, Progressive Hungary Foundation and FEPS will provide competitive knowledge, leadership and communication skills. This academy will equip the participants with the necessary learning and capacities to develop their political career.

Political Relevance

This Political Academy aims at reinforcing the knowledge and skills of promising progressive policymakers. The students of the academy are selected through a competitive selection process from the youth movements of the progressive political community and from Young progressive Hungarian politicians. The progressive youth movements included in this initiative are: the Societas, the Youth Caucus, the Spark Movement, the Green Front, the Red Front and the Green Generation.

Impact Plan

On the side of the SDI, the Anna Kéthly Political Academy shall have the following impact:

- Expand knowledge and competences on Europe and progressive strategies among young progressive Hungarians who could potentially run for office or advice key progressive political figures.
- Bind a network of young talents and experts (on Europe) to Social Democracy and the main topics on the EU Social Democrat agenda
- First-step preparation of the participants for a career in national politics but also in Brussels; by this, in the long run, more social democrats should be influential in the European Union
- Connecting the national foundation (ISD) training programme and the FEPS Training Strategy
- Ensuring cross-fertilization between FEPS Annual Autumn Academy and ISD training projects

VI. LIABILITIES

Contracting parties may exercise their right to apply force majeure in the case of extraordinary events or circumstances beyond their control preventing them from fulfilling their obligations. The parties should notify in advance to all parties any potential risk and plan jointly to minimize such risks.

VII. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY & BRANDING

- Any intellectual property resulting from this project is owned by FEPS. FEPS hereby grants access and reproduction rights of all intellectual property generated in the context of the present project to all parties involved in the present Framework Agreement.
- Any communication or publication produced in the framework of this project, including at a conference, seminar, or in any information or promotional materials (such as brochures, leaflets, posters, presentations in electronic form, etc.). shall indicate that the program has received financial support from the European Parliament and include its logo.
- The project shall be quoted in all forms of communication and publication as a joint project led by FEPS and carried out between all parties. Wherever possible, all communications and publications produced by the Parties in any form and any medium related to this project shall bear the logos of all Parties.
- Any communication or publication by the Parties in any form and any medium, shall indicate that sole liability rests with the author and that the European Parliament and the Parties are not responsible for any use that may be made of the information contained therein.



VIII. DISCLAIMERS

- The budget is only valid for the duration of the present Framework Agreement. Costs incurred before or after are not considered eligible unless it is agreed in writing by all parties through a contract amendment.
- Invoices and financial documentation shall include an explicit reference to the project in order to be considered eligible.

IX. TERMINATION


The present Framework Agreement is binding. Should any of the contracting parties wish to withdraw their support to the project, including the bilaterally financial contribution, an agreement in writing signed by all contracting parties needs to be formalized where a new budget and cost division is agreed.


X. DISPUTE RESOLUTION
